

Information to students admitted to MBBS Course 2017

All candidates admitted under Community quota (including NRI) need to execute a bond to serve the institution for a period of one year on successful completion of their MBBS course. All candidates concerned are hereby instructed to bring stamp papers worth Rs.200/- (Preferably stamp paper worth Rs.100X2) to execute the relevant bond, on 11th Sept. 2017.

All candidates admitted to the MBBS course 2017 need to execute a bond undertaking to pay liquidated damages if the candidate discontinues the course at any time after 31/08/2017 without completing the MBBS course. All candidate are instructed to bring stamp papers worth Rs.200/- (Preferably stamp paper worth Rs.100X2) to execute the relevant bond, on 11th Sept. 2017.

Note: The Text matter to be executed will be entered in the stamp paper at the Medical College Office.
